Narrative:

On Monday, May 20, 2024, at approximately 1000, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Andrew Harasimchuk (Harasimchuk) and BCI Administrative Professional Betsy Farris opened the sealed brown paper bag that contained Matrix Item #10. The purpose of opening Matrix Item #10 was to remove the \$30.00 in U.S. Currency and repackage the U.S. Currency in a separate property envelope. The U.S. Currency was removed and added into evidence as Matrix Item #55. Matrix Item #10 was then resealed.
