Narrative:

On Monday, October 21, 2024 at approximately 1009 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation Special Agent Supervisor William Jones and Special Agent Steven Seitzman attempted to make contact with Pamela Osborne at 1273 Rosedale Drive, Dayton, OH 45402. Ms. Osborne is believed to be the mother of Taylor Cotton and the person who initially called for the police on Saturday, October 19, 2024.

A male subject answered the door and stated that Ms. Osborne did not want to speak with the BCI agents but indicated she would be open to talking at a later time. SA Seitzman provided the male with a business card.

The interaction was captured on an audio recorder, which is attached below.
