Narrative:

On May 20, 2022, Special Agents Doug Eveslage and Kenneth Smith with the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) responded to an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) that occurred at 947 Business State Route 28, Milford, Clermont County, Ohio, involving the Miami Township Police Department and Camille Weems (Weems). SA's Eveslage and Smith interviewed Lori Smalls–Miller (Lori) about having information about Weems prior to the OICI in the parking lot of her apartment complex.

Lori stated that on May 19, 2022, Weems came to her apartment door asking for her husband, Trevor Smalls–Miller, and also wanted to know if Lori or her roommate knew anything about handling firearms or how they operate. Lori said, "I don't know anything," but her roommate Casey Greenberg went downstairs with Trevor Smalls–Miller to Weems' apartment for approximately one hour to help her learn how to operate her firearm. SA Eveslage asked if Lori saw any weapons on Weems' person when she was at her apartment door, and Lori said, "No."

Lori stated that on May 20, 2022, Weems called Casey Greenberg around 1300 or 1400 hours in the afternoon and asked him to "get her out of the state." Lori said that after Weems asked Casey Greenberg that, he blocked Weems' number on his cell phone.

SA Eveslage asked Lori if she has ever seen Weems' with any weapons at any time, but Lori said, "No."

This interview was concluded at 2045 hours. The interview was audio recorded. See attachment #01 for further details.
