Narrative:

On July 22, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Nick Valente (Valente) began reviewing background information on Shannon Sloan (Sloan), the subject involved in the June 18, 2024, officer-involved shooting incident that occurred in Wadsworth, Ohio. The information reviewed included past police reports involving the subject and reviewing the subject's documented criminal history records. The information gathered was obtained from the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit and the Wadsworth Police Department (WPD).

SA Valente reviewed all the information gathered and noted the following:

CCH:

Sloan did not have a CCH.

Prior Law Enforcement Contacts:

SA Eric Lehnhart (Lehnhart) requested WPD provide details regarding all previous encounters their agency had with Sloan. WPD provided police reports for eleven prior encounters the agency had with Sloan. SA Lehnhart received records and noted Sloan had multiple other encounters with law enforcement, to include traffic violations between 2006 and 2024.

On the above date I was advised that a worker from Children Services was at Overlook School for a report of child abuse. I was told that they were going to interview the suspect/father and requested an officer come to the school.

I arrived and spoke with Christina M Haney from Children Services and also ██████████ the school psychologist about an 8 year old male by the name of ██████████ ██████████ stated that ██████████ was seen with a red mark on the right side of his face that appeared to be in the shape of a hand. ██████████ stated that when she spoke with ██████████ about the mark on his face, he stated that his father had smacked him across the face last night. ██████████ contacted children services and Christina came out. They were able to determine that ██████████ got into an argument with his older sister ██████████ and was disciplined about this by his father by being spanked on the bottom. He then stated that he was screaming and his father, Shannon smacked him across the face. ██████████ also stated to ██████████ and Christina that his father told him not to say anything about what happened.

When I arrived ██████████ had already been sent back to his classroom and his father arrived shortly after. Shannon seemed to be irritated with CSB and also my presence and was giving only very short answers. He did not deny spanking ██████████ and stated that he smacked him in the face because ██████████ was yelling and screaming. He stated that he did not hit him with any force and that he did not see any mark on ██████████ this morning when he left for school or last night after the incident.

Shannon stated that his wife was currently out of the country for a few days visiting a relative from the armed services. He stated that she was due back on Tuesday. He stated that he was not under any stress and felt that CSB being called was a bunch of crap. Christina stated that CSB was not trying to tell him how to raise his children but their well being was most important, Shannon was upset and again gave very short answers. He did agree to a safety plan for the children and agreed that he would not use any physical discipline. He also agreed to have CSB come to the house on Tuesday so they could speak to the other children and also his wife.

Shannon then left and I talked briefly with Christina, we both agreed that there did not seem to be any immediate danger to the children and no reason to remove them from the house, there was no history of any calls with our department involving violence of any kind, for either parent. Christina then showed me two photos that she had taken of ██████████'s right cheek area and you could clearly see red marks on the side of his face. I gave her the case number and advised her that I would send this to the detective bureau and she could follow up with them.

Supplement Title: Hit / Skip Investigation

On 8/17/17 I responded to the area of High Street near Walmart for a report of a hit skip crash. The suspect vehicle was leaving the area with the victim following it. The suspect vehicle was described as a jeep SUV with license plate GNGBEV3. The victim was asked to meet me at Fire Station #2. He described the driver as being a white female, in her 30s, with short blonde hair. She stopped immediately after the accident and got out of the car. When the victim advised he had to call for a police report, the suspect fled the scene in her vehicle.

I contacted the suspect vehicle owner, [REDACTED] by phone shortly after the accident. He did not know who would have his vehicle. I explained that the driver matched the description of his wife, [REDACTED] but he didn't know why she would be in Wadsworth. He agreed to make some phone calls and call me back. I did not hear back from him. I called him back again and he advised he still hadn't figured out who had his car.

I called [REDACTED] again on 8/19/17 and left a message.

On 8/20/17 I received a voicemail from [REDACTED] advising that he wanted to talk to a lawyer before making contacting me back.

On 8/21/17 I received a voicemail from John Cameron, attorney for [REDACTED] (330-722-8989). I called him back on 8/22/17. He explained that he would like to accompany [REDACTED] when she talked to me. He agreed to call me tomorrow with a time to meet. He mentioned that it was his understanding that an "exotic dancer" who had been living with the [REDACTED]s took the car. She has since moved out. I asked them to bring the insurance info for the vehicle as well.

On 8/24/17 I called John Cameron's office again because he had not called to scheduled a time to meet me. The secretary took my information and stated he would call me back. He did not.

On 8/25/17 I called John Cameron's office again. I spoke with the secretary, who confirmed that we are trying to set up a time to meet with [REDACTED]. She took my info again and agreed to call me back.

On 8/26/17 I still have not heard anything from the Handys or the law firm.

On 8/29/17 I received a call from Margaret at John Cameron's office. She gave me the name of the driver that [REDACTED] said was operating the vehicle at the time of the crash. The driver's name is [REDACTED] but she did not know any more information than that. [REDACTED] lived with [REDACTED] at the time of this incident but they kicked her out after learning about the crash. [REDACTED] intends to call [REDACTED] to obtain more information and then contact the attorney who will then contact me. I was unable to positively identify a suspect based on this very limited information and preliminary database searches.

On 9/14/17 I spoke with Margaret again. She provided a phone number for the suspect, [REDACTED]. She also advised that she would attempt to contact the [REDACTED] to see if they had obtained any additional information. She didn't have any other information at the time. I did not hear back from Margaret that day.

I checked the given phone number through TLO but did not locate any matches.

I attempted to call the given number for [REDACTED] on 9/17/17 but it rang busy.

As of 9/22/17 I still have not received information from the attorney's office that I had requested or even a call back. I called [REDACTED] and left a voicemail asking for a return call. The suspect number I was provided continues to ring busy. Appolo Heating and Cooling called and left a voicemail asking for an update. I returned that call but was placed on hold and had to eventually disconnect.

On 9/23/17 I received a voicemail from [REDACTED]. He explained the situation. He advised that times are tough and his wife took a second job. At the job, she befriended the driver in this case, [REDACTED] lost her home and needed a place to stay. Because [REDACTED] has a suspended license, they allowed [REDACTED] to live with them so Heidi could drive them to and from work. On the day of this incident, [REDACTED] dropped [REDACTED] off at work and took the car to 'run some errands.' [REDACTED] believes this is when the accident occurred. [REDACTED] now doubts that this was her real name and advised the phone number they had for her has been disconnected. He offered to pay for the damages to the other vehicle.

Based on the information I have, there is no way to track down the suspect driver in this case.

I was assigned this case to follow up on. Det. Schismenos and I went to [REDACTED]'s house in Medina to speak to her but she was not home. We did speak to her husband who told us that he does not know who was driving the vehicle. He works all day and was not home. They had a woman who they knew as [REDACTED] staying with them for the past few weeks to help her out. He did not know [REDACTED] but [REDACTED] knew her from where she works at Lusty's in Akron. Lusty's is a strip club. He did not mind having [REDACTED] stay with them since she has a license and [REDACTED] does not. [REDACTED] would be able to take [REDACTED] back and forth to work for him. [REDACTED] lost her license from an OVI recently (Aug. 5, 2017). He never met [REDACTED] before she came to stay with them. He said that he does not know if [REDACTED] is her real name either now. On the day of the accident [REDACTED] called him and said that [REDACTED] did not come pick her up from work so she had to stay there until about 9:00pm when he was able to go get her. When he got home he noticed that the Jeep was in the driveway and all of [REDACTED]'s things were gone. They tried to call [REDACTED] on the phone number [REDACTED] had for her, but it was no longer a working number. He described [REDACTED] as a W/F with shoulder length strawberry blonde hair, in her mid to late 20's and thin. I explained that I thought it was odd that he and [REDACTED] let a woman they really do not know, stay with them and drive their vehicle. He replied that she seemed nice, [REDACTED] seemed to know her and she was down on her luck at the time. He verified that [REDACTED] is a stripper but also has a drinking problem and that is why they have a strained marriage. [REDACTED] is dealing with an OVI and is looking at going to jail for a year for it. He said that he does not like her stripping but its good money and he needs the income. At the end of our conversation he again stated that a woman he knew as [REDACTED] was staying with them but he does not know who was driving the Jeep the day of the accident.

After speaking to [REDACTED] I was able to speak to his neighbors next door to the south of his residence. The female there advised that she was not aware of any other woman staying at the [REDACTED]'s house as [REDACTED] stated. Her husband said he had not seen anyone else besides [REDACTED] or their son. They told me [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]'s son has blonde hair and usually drives the Jeep but they have not seen another female especially as I described staying there or driving the Jeep. They seemed very confident that [REDACTED] was lying. I was not able to speak to any other neighbors due to no one was home.

I called [REDACTED] on the phone number [REDACTED] gave me for her so I could ask her about the accident and to get her son's phone number so I could call and speak to him. She denied driving the Jeep that day and told me that her son would not know anything about the accident since he was not there. When I asked her how she would know that if she was not at the accident seen that day and then she hung up on me.

A few days later Det. Schismenos and I went to Lusty's to speak to the owner Stan, to verify [REDACTED]'s time at work on August 17th and to see if he has another employee named [REDACTED] who works for him. Stan was not at Lusty's but I was able to speak to him by phone. He said that he does not know what time [REDACTED] was at work on Aug. 17th but that she usually works from 1100 am until about 4:00pm. He said it is very rare that she would be there past 5:00pm. He said that he is not familiar with anyone named [REDACTED] but he would check his records and also check with his night bartender. He said that the bartenders sign the girls in and out. I spoke with the bartender currently working and she stated that she is not aware of any dancer by the name of [REDACTED] working there. She said that when dancers apply to work there they have to show ID and that name she was not familiar with. She asked a couple other dancers who were currently working and they both said they did not know any [REDACTED] or a dancer matching that description. They advised that there are only about 4-6 dancers working at a time and the day shift girls do not work night shifts. One of the dancers, [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] is a liar and she causes a lot of trouble there. She told me that some dancers use fake names but that all of them know each others real name, the fake names are for the customers.

While there I was told that [REDACTED] was currently working so I went to talk to her. She was on the phone with someone from the law firm that she said is representing her for her current OVI case. She said that she did not wish to speak to me without them present and handed me her phone. Upon arrival, Haydon had retreated to his room already and Ptl Seiler and Ptl Ball went to speak to him inside while I spoke to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] outside.

[REDACTED] said that he went into [REDACTED]'s room to take a video game away from him because he had been fighting with his brother about it. [REDACTED] said that he was able to wrestle [REDACTED] into a control hold and then slowly left the room. He went into the kitchen where [REDACTED] then continued to scream at him and charged him. [REDACTED] punched [REDACTED] several times in the left side of the head and [REDACTED] hit his mouth on something, possibly the ground when [REDACTED] took him down. Once [REDACTED] realized his mother was on the phone with WPD he went to his room. There was not an injury to his head but there was broken blood vessels on the inside of [REDACTED]'s lip.
