Narrative:

On December 21, 2022, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) was requested to investigate the facts and circumstances surrounding an Officer–Involved Critical Incident (OICI) that occurred at Sidney Foodtown, located at 1010 Wapakoneta Avenue, Sidney, Ohio (Shelby County). The OICI occurred when Sidney police officers encountered Todd Jordan (Todd), who was armed with a gun inside Sidney Foodtown.

On December 21, 2022, Special Agents Lauren Frazier and Steve Seitzman spoke with Sherri Redinbo King. The interview was conducted via phone at Sherri's request due to her being sick. The details below summarize the pertinent portions of the recorded interview. Please refer to the audio recording for additional information. The interview began at approximately 1315 hours.

Sherri stated that she was an acquaintance of both Todd Jordan (Todd) and Annette "Annie" Wooddell (Annie) and has known them for several years. Sherri stated that she last spoke with Todd approximately 4–5 months ago. Sherri said that Todd was an alcoholic. Sherri explained that she recorded an audio conversation between herself and Annie from several years ago. During this conversation, Annie told Sherri that she smashed three "oxy" pills and put them in Todd's beer to "get him to pass out." Sherri sent the recorded conversation to Todd a few months ago and Todd later filed a report, which she believed was with the Sidney Police Department.

Sherri went on to say that Todd has made several threats in the past towards her. She explained that Annie told her that Todd had bought a gun, specifically a rifle (on layaway at Walmart), and Todd said he was going to kill her. Sherri stated that Annie and Todd's relationship was always "chaos" and that they were kicked out of several places. She stated that they were always fighting with each other and that there are a lot of police reports involving them.

Sherri did not recall any recent threats made by Todd towards Annie or Annie's son, Dylan Wooddell. Sherri stated that she was contacted by Dan Wooddell, Dylan's father, advising her about what happened regarding the shooting at Sidney Foodtown.
